Park and Ride Options to the University of St. Thomas

There are many public transit options to the University of St. Thomas's St. Paul campus. In addition to the 21, 63, 87, and 134 Metro Transit buses which serve the campus directly, it's possible to incorporate public transit into your commute by using a park and ride station. And did you know that you can combine a public transit trip with the St. Thomas shuttle? Here are some ideas to inspire you!

South

If coming from the South, park at the <u>28th Avenue station in Bloomington</u>. Board the Blue Line light rail headed North to downtown. Get off at the Lake Street station and head down the stairs. There is a bus shelter on the South side of Lake Street. Take the 21 Eastbound to Summit Ave and Cretin Ave. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 47 minutes.

North

If coming from the North, park at <u>County Road H Park and Ride</u> in Mounds View. Board the 250 Southbound express bus.

Option A: Get off at the Marquette Avenue and 5th street stop. Walk a block to the corner of 6th and Marquette to board the 134 Eastbound. Disembark at Summit Ave and Cretin Ave. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 52 minutes.

Option B: Get off at the Marquette Avenue and 11th street stop. Walk two blocks over to the University of St. Thomas's downtown Minneapolis campus. Hop on the St. Thomas shuttle for a non-stop ride. Total trip time estimate: 54 minutes.

Another option for coming from the North is to park at Rosedale Shopping Center in Roseville. While not an official Park and Ride, the A line bus rapid transit is a hi-frequency route between Roseville and St. Paul. Take the A line to Grand Avenue and Snelling Avenue. Transfer to the 63 Westbound. Disembark at Grand Avenue and Finn Street. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 36 minutes.

East

If coming from the East, park at <u>Hadley Avenue and Upper 17th St Park & Ride</u> in Oakdale. Board the 294 Southbound. Disembark at the Smith Ave Ramp in downtown St. Paul at Smith Avenue and 5th Street. Transfer here for the 63 Westbound. Disembark at Grand Ave and Finn Street. You have arrived at St. Thomas! Total trip time estimate: 55 minutes.

West

If coming from the West, park at the <u>Wayzata Blvd. & Barry Ave. Park & Ride</u> in Wayzata. Take the 672, 674, or 675 to 12th Street South and Yale Place at the University of St. Thomas in downtown Minneapolis. Transfer here to the St. Thomas shuttle for a non-stop ride to the University of St. Thomas's St. Paul Campus! Total trip time estimate: 55 minutes.
